## READ EPHESIANS 1:13

After we believed we were  $\frac{19}{19} = \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1}{12} = \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1}{4}$  with the Holy Spirit of promise.

2) God has his signature on us. In Paul's day (God chose him to write Ephesians), leaders would have a special logo to put on things that belonged to them. It is kind of like when your mom wrote your name in the underwear you packed for summer camp. She didn't want you to lose them, so she wrote your name in big block letters for all your cabin mates to see. What God wants us to know is that He isn't going to lose us. The Holy Spirit living inside you says that you belong to Him.

# Have you ever received a 100% on a test at school? If you got a 100%, would you try to do better?


God wants you to know that there is nothing more to be added to your salvation. God graded the payment of Jesus Christ and it was perfect (100%). You are saved by what Christ has done, so you are 100% saved. You don't have to try to do better. You can't do better.



The word "complete" can also mean "full." Picture a cup that is filled to the brim with your favorite drink. What happens if you try to add more?

The same is true of our salvation. We are filled up in Christ. We can't add any more to it. God wants you to know that you are fully saved.

## READ ROMANS 3:37-39



When you are playing a game on your Wii or Tablet, once you defeat the boss of a level, you don't have to play that level over and over again. You have already won. You have victory. God wants you to know that He hasn't just won the war against sin and death, but He has made us more than winners. There is no more war to fight. Christ fought the battle and won.
